Dear ESC Licensing team

I refer to the letter to Sumo Power attached to the email below, and the separate letter to Sumo Gas of the same date.

You note that no changes are proposed to the particulars of the licences unless we hear from you separately, which I don't believe we have. Sumo previously responded with updates to the particulars of the proposed licences, so I have re-attached our previous response which contains those updates. Can you please ensure the particulars are updated.

You have requested Sumo's email address for service. We would prefer not to provide a fixed email address for service in the licence itself. Such an email address would be subject to change, and documents served on Sumo might not be received if the relevant recipient no longer works at Sumo. We consider that the existing process, whereby the ESC requests confirmation that Sumo will accept service by email on each occasion, continues to be appropriate. Otherwise, Sumo's registered address remains the appropriate address for service.

Subject to the above matters, and subject to the Sumo licences as varied being consistent with the varied licences for all other energy retailers, we consent to the revised proposal.
