

Greater Metropolitan Water Price Review Melbourne Water: Final decision outcomes for 2013-14 to 2017-18

June 2013

Breakdown of costs*

The ESC's final decision has approved a reduction of Melbourne Water's proposed costs of 6.6% (or \$564 million) over the five years from 2013-14.




Aggregate prices*

The ESC's final decision has approved an increase in average prices of 47.1% over the five years from 2013-14.

Water and sewerage prices* The ESC's final decision has approved an increase in prices of 54.1% over the five years from 2013-14.

Waterways and drainage prices*

The ESC's final decision has approved an increase in average prices of 7.1% over the five years from 2013-14.
