




Final decision outcomes for 2013-14 to 2017-18

# Breakdown of costs\*

The ESC's final decision has approved a reduction of South Gippsland Water's costs of 6.7% (or \$9 million) over the five years from 2013-14.







# **Prices**\*

The ESC's final decision has approved a reduction in average prices of 4.8% over the five years from 2013-14.

Indicative household bills (owner-occupier)\*\*

The ESC's final decision has approved that over the next five years, indicative South Gippsland Water household bills would be reduced by \$483\*.

# Key Final Decision Outcomes

# Expenditure

#### Operating Expenditure

- The final approved operating expenditure by the Commission is \$81.0 million.
- This is \$3.4 million (4.0 per cent) lower than the proposed expenditure of \$84.4 million.

# Capital Expenditure

- South Gippsland Water proposed capital expenditure of \$72.0 million.
- The Commission's final decision approved capital expenditure of \$66.6 million.
- This is \$5.4 million (7.5 per cent) lower than the proposed expenditure by the water business.

# Tariffs

# Retail Water Tariffs

- South Gippsland Water proposed to maintain their existing two-part tariffs for residential customers a fixed service charge and a single variable charge.
- In its final decision, the Commission has approved the price structure of residential and non-residential retail water tariffs proposed by South Gippsland Water.

#### Recycled Water Tariffs

- South Gippsland Water proposed to maintain a two part tariff structure a fixed component and a variable component for residential and non-residential sewerage tariffs.
- The Commission has approved South Gippsland Water's proposal to maintain existing tariff structures for residential and non-residential sewerage services in its final decision.
