I apologise for late submission but I want to make a submission on the gross overcharging via infrastructure fee while water access storage charges remain minor. The water has no value sitting in the dams, its only in combination with the supply network that it gains its value. This forms the basis for why the entitlement owners (mainly non-farmers now) should pay for the network infrastructure costs. A modest increase in storage charge would go a very long way to reducing the burden on farmers in the system.
