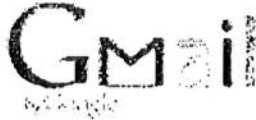

REVIEW OF VICTORIAN WATER PRICES 2013-18

Call for public comment on proposed water prices

The Essential Services Commission is the economic regulator of Victoria's water industry.

We are presently assessing the service and pricing proposals ('water plans') of the state's water businesses for the 2013-18 period.

Victoria's 19 water businesses have submitted their water plans to the Commission, proposing water prices to apply from 1 July 2013.

The water plans outline a range of capital and operating expenditure to be undertaken over the five-year period.

(Goulburn-Murray Water's regulatory period is for three years.)

In November, we will start a period of public consultation, and we want to hear and receive customers' views on the water plans proposed by the following water businesses:

We will assess the water plans of each water business and make a draft decision on the prices, and seek further public
