Grampians Wool Industries employs about 45 staff and is a major financial contributor to the Hamilton region the "wool capital of Australia".

I am informed that should the proposed water and trade waste water charges come into effect, the business may no longer be viable and may be forced to close.

Grampians Wool Industries has met and complied with conditions placed on them by Glenelg/Wannon Water, but they are extremely concerned their costs could increase by nearly 200% in two years.

Grampians Wool Industries are aware of the new water pricing strategy; however they are very concerned at the increase and are requesting that, if approved, it be via an incremental increase which would allow the company to remain a viable business.

I strongly support there be incremental change over a longer period than the suggested two years.
